Reviewed Week One: PRAY Silently in Preparing for Worship

What is prayer? Talking to God...

What does prepare mean? Getting ready

What does worship means? To show and tell God how much we love and appreciate him

Why do we want to worship our Lord?

1 Chronicles 16:25-36: “*For great is the Lord and greatly to be praised; He is also to be feared above all gods. For all the gods of the peoples are idols, but the Lord made the heavens. Splendor and majesty are before Him, strength and joy are in His place...*”

What types of things show that we are preparing for worship?

Walking quietly into the church/the sanctuary

Having our Bibles

Opening our Bibles quietly

Getting the hymnals from the back of the church pews quietly and carefully

Not talking with those around us

Week two: CALL TO WORSHIP

This is like calling you to dinner...stop what you are doing...come to the meal prepared for you.

Our pastor calls us as a group to come worship our Lord

Come, let's pray

Come, let's sing

Come, let's hear God's Word told to us

Learning to use the children's bulletin

Listening to our pastor preach

Interacting with others respectfully and lovingly
